A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH GLENNA HUGGINS ESTATE, EXECUTOR JERRY MARTINEZ FOR THE PURCHASE OF REAL ESTATE LOT 1694, SUR 22 L A L N/2 & SW/4, ACRES 5.03 FOR THE ABILENE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, the Abilene Fire Department (AFD) was approved for a 2022 Bond Project to design and construct Fire Station 9 on the Southside of Abilene; and

WHEREAS, City-owned property was originally identified for this project but has been determined to possess constraints due to utility service lines; and

WHEREAS, has identified property and acreage located at 1102 Beltway as a suitable site to build Fire Station 9; and

WHEREAS, \$525,000.00 plus closing costs will be funded from the City of Abilene General Fund and will be reimbursed by bond proceeds (pending bond counsel approval), MIP, the Fire Apparatus Fund, or a combination of the three.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Part 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an Agreement with Glenna Huggins Estate, Executor Jerry Martinez.
