

RESOLUTION NO. 101-2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER NO. 3 TO THE CONTRACT WITH UDELHOVEN OILFIELD SYSTEM SERVICES, INC. FOR THE LAKE FORT PHANTOM HILL PUMP STATION IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates a Public Water Supply System that includes the Lake Fort Phantom Intake Pump Station (Pump Station); and

WHEREAS, on May 27, 2021 the Abilene City Council awarded the bid to Udelhoven Oilfield System Services, Inc. (Udelhoven) for the Lake Fort Phantom Hill Pump Station Improvements Project in the amount of \$2,049,955.00; and

WHEREAS, the project provided for the replacement of two aged Variable Frequency Drive (VFD) units and two aged soft start units with two VFD units capable of simultaneously controlling the operating speed of all four pumps, the rehabilitation of the four pumping units, the replacement of the control building HVAC unit, and other miscellaneous work; and

WHEREAS, the Project Engineer Jacob and Martin, LLC (JM), Udelhoven, and City staff do agree to remove the rehabilitation of pumps #2 and #3 from the scope of work of the contract which results in a reduction in the total value of the contract; and

WHEREAS, City staff recommends the approval of Change Order No. 3 to the contract with Udelhoven Oilfield System Services, Inc. (Udelhoven) which removes the rehabilitation of pumps No. 2 and No. 3 and decreases the contract value by \$86,084.00 resulting in a final contract value of \$1,963,871.00; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute Change Order No. 3 to the contract with Udelhoven Oilfield System Services, Inc. for the Lake Fort Phantom Hill Pump Station Improvements Project which reduces the contract value by \$86,084.00 for a final contract value of \$1,963,871.00.
