

RESOLUTION NO. 102-2023

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,
TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A
HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX MANAGEMENT AND USE AGREEMENT
WITH THE EXPO CENTER OF TAYLOR COUNTY**

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (“City”) grants hotel occupancy tax management and use agreements to the Chamber of Commerce for the purposes set forth in Chapter 351 of the Texas Tax Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the city of Abilene now desires to grant a hotel occupancy tax management and use agreement to the Expo Center of Taylor County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 351.101(c) of the Texas Tax Code, the City of Abilene is authorized to enter into said hotel occupancy management and use agreement;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

- Part 1. That the findings of the City and its actions approving this resolution taken at the City Council meeting are hereby approved and adopted.
- Part 2. That the City Manager is authorized to enter into an hotel occupancy tax management and use agreement with the Expo Center of Taylor County in the amount of 3% of hotel occupancy tax receipts pursuant to Chapter 351.101(c) of the Texas Tax Code.
- Part 3. That the City Manager is authorized to execute any amendments to any other hotel management use agreements with the Chamber of Commerce to effectuate a 2% reduction in hotel occupancy tax for the Chamber’s component entities.
- Part 4. That the City Manager is directed to reduce the amount of hotel occupancy tax revenues used by the Convention Center by 1%.
