RESOLUTION NO. 121-2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH JACOB & MARTIN, LLC FOR THE EVALUATION AND DESIGN OF THE GRIMES WATER TREATMENT PLANT REHABILITATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (Abilene) owns and operates a Public Water Supply System which includes the Grimes, Northeast, and Hargesheimer Water Treatment Plants; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 Water Treatment Plant Master Plan recommends the eventual decommissioning of the Grimes Water Treatment Plant after completing projects for replacing its capacity with expansions of the Northeast and Hargesheimer Water Treatment Plants, and the construction of the Cross Town Raw Water Pipeline; and

WHEREAS, the Grimes Water Treatment Plant was constructed in 1941 and has been renovated and expanded several times over the years, and metal structures within the clarifiers and the elevated backwash tank are severely corroded and in need of metal repairs, sandblasting, and recoating, and the filter media needs to be replaced; and

WHEREAS, the professional services contract with Jacob & Martin, LLC for the Evaluation and Design of the Grimes Water Treatment Plant Rehabilitation will provide for Evaluation, preparation of design plans and contract documents, bidding assistance, contract administration, project general supervision (not RPR), and additional Engineering services for 3rd party paint and welding inspections in the amount not to exceed \$70,000.00; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute the professional services contract with Jacob & Martin, LLC for the Evaluation and Design of the Grimes Water Treatment Plant Rehabilitation in the amount not to exceed \$70,000.00.
