## **RESOLUTION NO. 135-2023**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING BID TO THE CROWE GROUP, INC., ABILENE, TEXAS

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such notice, as required by law, for bids for the Festival District Project. This construction contract involves work around the Convention Center along the fire lane on N. 6<sup>th</sup> St. Included in the contract is the removal of miscellaneous concrete appurtenances as well as placement of new concrete structures and pavement. Items also included but are not limited to a French Drain system, landscaping, irrigation systems, electrical work, bollards, lighting, and site protection. Also included were two add alternates, add alternate 1 being a walkway canopy structure and add alternate 2 being a alternate finish for some of the concrete work.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene has utilitized the "Best Value" competitive bidding method in determining the award of the contract; and,

WHEREAS, The Crowe Group, Inc. of Abilene, Texas submitted the best value base bid amount of \$1,366,174.18 and an add alternate 1 bid of \$505,545.00 for a total of \$1,871,719.18 with the bid meeting specifications. Staff recommends awarding the base bid and add alternate 1 to the best value bidder, The Crowe Group, Inc., Abilene, Texas.
