## **RESOLUTION NO. 137-2023**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT PUMP FROM XYLEM WATER SOLUTIONS USA, INC. FOR THE PRISION LIFT STATION.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility and the wastewater collection system; and

WHEREAS, the wastewater collection system includes the prison lift station which serves the French Robertson and John Middleton Prison Units; and

WHEREAS, one of the three submersible lift station pumps has failed and must be replaced at a cost exceeding \$50,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the lift station is equipped with Flygt brand submersible pumps and compatible rail and coupling systems to allow the pumps to be pulled and reinstalled from the above deck surface without human entry into the lift station; and

WHEREAS, staff is requesting that the Abilene City Council approve the purchase of a new Flygt brand submersible lift station pump from parent company Xylem Water Solutions USA Inc. in the amount of 54,852.00; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the Abilene City Council approves the purchase of replacement lift station pump from Xylem Water Solutions USA, Inc. in the amount of \$54,852.00.
