RESOLUTION NO. 169-2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF ABILENE TO INSTALL FOUR-WAY STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF WESTCHESTER DR. AND BRUCE DR.

WHEREAS, residents in the Countryside South subdivision have expressed the desire to have four-way stop signs installed at the intersection of Westchester Dr. and Bruce Dr.; and

WHEREAS, Abilene City Ordinance Section 18-67 requires traffic control devices to conform to the manual and specifications approved by the state or conform to City Council resolution; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene performed a traffic analysis to determine if the installation of stop signs would be warranted; and,

WHEREAS, it was determined that the installation of stop signs for the purpose of speed control on Westchester Dr. would not conform with the state specifications; and,

WHEREAS, there is no other alternate method for the Countryside South subdivision residents to accomplish the installation of four-way stop signs at this location other than by City Council approval; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS

PART 1: The City of Abilene formally resolves that four-way stop signs should be installed at the intersection of Westchester Dr. and Bruce Dr.

PART 2: The City Manager or designee is authorized to install four-way stop signs in accordance with this resolution.
