

**RESOLUTION NO. 185-2023**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING THE BASE BID WITH ALTERNATE BID A TO ADVENTURES OUTBACK, LP DBA AO SERVICES FOR THE POSSUM KINGDOM DROUGHT RESPONSE IMPROVEMENTS RO CONCENTRATE PIPELINE – PHASE II PROJECT.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates a Public Water System that provides drinking water for the City and the region and includes the Possum Kingdom Raw Water Roughing Facility (PKRWRF) as a component of the raw water supply delivery systems; and

**WHEREAS**, the PKRWRF construction project included the installation of a segment of RO Concentrate pipeline from the PKRWRF to the intersection of State Highway 67 and FM 1148, where construction was halted until the City could acquire the appropriate TPDES permit; and

**WHEREAS**, the Possum Kingdom Drought Response Improvements RO Concentrate Pipeline – Phase II is the installation of approximately 38,667 feet of 12inch diameter pipeline along FM 1148 to complete the RO Concentrate Pipeline for discharging RO concentrate into the lake; and


**WHEREAS**, Adventures Outback, LP dba AO Services (AO Services) submitted the lowest price for the Base Bid with Alternate Bid A for the Possum Kingdom Drought Response Improvements RO Concentrate Pipeline – Phase II project, and the design engineer Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. has evaluated the bids for best value criteria and for conformity with the advertisement for bids and does recommend awarding the bid to AO Services in the amount of \$4,858,204.00; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

That the City Manager is authorized to execute a construction contract with Adventures Outback, LP dba AO Services for the Possum Kingdom Drought Response Improvements RO Concentrate Pipeline – Phase II project in the amount of \$4,858,204.00.
