RESOLUTION NO. 187-2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH ENPROTEC/HIBBS & TODD, INC. FOR THE NORTHEAST WATER TREATMENT PLANT IMPROVEMENTS-PRELIMINARY DESIGN.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (Abilene) owns and operates a public water supply system which includes the Northeast, Grimes, and Hargesheimer Water Treatment Plants; and

WHEREAS, the Northeast Water Treatment Plant (Northeast WTP) has a rated capacity of 25 million gallons per day, however it is aging and in need of heavy maintenance, upgrades, and renovation in order to ensure future capacity and reliability, and

WHEREAS, the 2020 Water Treatment Plant Master Plan recommends the rehabilitation of the Northeast WTP including the superpulsator clarifiers, filter media rehab, chemical and electrical system improvements, and the construction of a new high service pump station; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene Emergency Preparedness Plan, as approved by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality in June 2023, requires the installation of emergency backup generation at the Northeast WTP by December 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the professional services contract with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. for the Northeast Water Treatment Plant Improvements-Preliminary Design will provide for evaluation and preliminary design (30%) for rehabilitation of superpulsators, filters and gallery valves, electrical and chemical systems, and a new high service pump station, addition of emergency power generation, and other related tasks in the amount not to exceed \$750,000.00; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute the professional services contract with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. for the Northeast Water Treatment Plant Improvements-Preliminary Design in the amount not to exceed \$750,000.00.
