

RESOLUTION NO. 208-2023

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS APPROVING AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS AND THE ABILENE-TAYLOR COUNTY EVENTS VENUE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, authorizes any local government to contract with one or more local governments to perform governmental functions and services under the terms of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Abilene-Taylor County Events Venue District is holding a special election on November 7, 2023, to authorize the Events Venue District to finance a venue project: i.e. City of Abilene Frontier Texas! and the EXPO Center of Taylor County; and

WHEREAS, the Events Venue District seeks to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with the City of Abilene and Taylor County for the costs of the election, whereby the City and the County will pay the costs of the election, and the Events Venue District shall reimburse the City and County for the cost; and

WHEREAS, the City and County shall each pay 1/2 of the cost, and the Events Venue District shall repay the cost in the amount of \$10,000 per month beginning October 1, 2024, as set forth in the Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Taylor County Commissioners' Court approved the Interlocal Agreement at its October 24, 2023 meeting.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


Part 1: That the City Council, pursuant to Section 42.022 of the Texas Local Government Code, hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into an Interlocal Agreement with Taylor County, Texas and the Abilene-Taylor County Events Venue District for the costs to hold a special election to authorize the Events Venue District to finance a venue project.

Part 2: That this Resolution becomes effective immediately upon adoption.
