

**RESOLUTION NO. 227-2023**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CONTRACT WITH ACE PIPE CLEANING, INC. THROUGH PURCHASING COOPERATIVE OF AMERICA FOR THE I-20 & LOOP 322 SEWER LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT.**

**WHEREAS,** On May 25, 2023 the Abilene City Council approved a contract with Ace Pipe Cleaning, Inc., for the Heavy Cleaning, CCTV Inspection, and CIPP Insertion Lining of Certain Sewer Main Sections; and

**WHEREAS,** during initial efforts at heavy cleaning it was determined that the 12inch pipe crossing under I-20 had failed and therefore the CIPP insertion cannot be installed; and

**WHEREAS,** on July 27, 2023 the Abilene City Council approved a change order No. 1 to the contract for the deletion of heavy cleaning and CIPP insertion and the addition of pipe bursting and installation of 12inch HDPE pipe, and due to complications beyond the control of ACE and the City, the pipe bursting installation did not result in an acceptable finished product; and

**WHEREAS,** on December 21, 2023 the Abilene City Council approved Change Order No. 2 to delete from the contract the work tasks of Change Order No. 1; and

**WHEREAS,** the City hired Jacob and Martin, LLC to provide an engineered solution, and the engineer recommends installing an encased parallel bore and 12inch HDPE sewer main; and


**WHEREAS,** City staff recommends that the Abilene City Council approve the contract with ACE Pipe Cleaning, Inc., available through Purchasing Cooperative of America at contract pricing in compliance with Texas Local Government Code Chapter 271, for the I-20 & Loop 322 Sewer Line Replacement project in the amount of \$419,216.24; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

That the Abilene City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute the contract with Ace Pipe Cleaning, Inc. for the I-20 & Loop 322 Sewer Line Replacement project in the amount of \$419,216.24.


