

**RESOLUTION NO. 51-2024**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH KING CONSULTANTS ENVIRONMENTAL FOR THE DEMOLITION SPECIFICATIONS AND MONITORING AT CESAR CHAVEZ AND G.V. DANIELS RECREATION CENTERS**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene completed a Recreation Feasibility Study in 2020 that recommended replacement of Cesar Chavez and G.V. Daniels Recreation Centers; and

**WHEREAS**, the citizens of Abilene voted to pass a 2023 bond for development of two new recreation centers replacing existing Cesar Chavez and G.V. Daniels Recreation Centers; and

**WHEREAS**, the City seeks to contract with King Consultants Environmental to conduct the demolition specifications and monitoring for both recreation centers; and

**WHEREAS**, King Consultants Environmental is an authorized contractor through contract #230601 of The Inter-Local Purchasing System (TIPS) purchasing co-op, and competitive bidding is not required.


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**



Part 2: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after passage.


