

**RESOLUTION NO. 54-2024**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH ENPROTEC/HIBBS & TODD, INC. FOR THE PK RAW WATER ROUGHING FACILITY RO CONCENTRATE PIPELINE CONSTRUCTION - PHASE 2.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates a Public Water System that provides drinking water for the City and the region and includes the Possum Kingdom Raw Water Roughing Facility (PKRWRf) as a component of the raw water supply delivery systems; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 12, 2023 the Abilene City Council awarded the bid to Adventures Outback, LP dba AO Services (AO Services) for the Possum Kingdom Drought Response Improvements RO Concentrate Pipeline – Phase II project, and the contractor is now mobilizing for construction; and

**WHEREAS**, City staff recommends the services of a Resident Project Representative to provide regular on-site observation and inspection considering the remote location of the project, the project is being constructed within the TxDOT right-of-way of FM 1148, and the rocky conditions that exist throughout the length of project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Professional Services Contract with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. (eHT) for the PK Raw Water Roughing Facility RO Concentrate Pipeline Construction - Phase 2 project will provide for construction phase services, Resident Project Representation, construction materials testing, record drawing development, and post-construction phase services in an amount not to exceed \$340,000.00; and


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

That the City Manager is authorized to execute a professional services contract with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. for the PK Raw Water Roughing Facility RO Concentrate Pipeline Construction – Phase 2 for the amount not to exceed \$340,000.00.
