

RESOLUTION NO. 55-2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH JACOB & MARTIN, LLC FOR THE ELEVATED STORAGE TANK IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (Abilene) owns and operates the Public Water Supply System which includes elevated water storage tanks to provide stabilized pressure within the water distribution system and to meet peak water demands; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 Water Distribution Master Plan (WDMP) recommends the construction of a new 1.5 million gallon elevated water storage tank be constructed in the western edge of the second pressure plane to correct deficiencies in elevated storage capacity; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 WDMP recommends the construction of a new 1.5 million gallon elevated water storage tank to be constructed in the central area of the first pressure plane to replace the capacity of the existing Highland elevated storage tank, which will then be demolished; and


WHEREAS, the professional services contract with Jacob & Martin, LLC for the Elevated Storage Tank Improvements will provide for engineering services for planning, land acquisition, design, bidding, and construction review (not RPR) for two new elevated water storage tanks in the amount not to exceed \$637,500.00; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to execute the professional services contract with Jacob & Martin, LLC for the Elevated Storage Tank Improvements in the amount not to exceed \$637,500.00.
