

RESOLUTION NO. 70-2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING BID TO WILLIS ELECTRIC CO. LP., ABILENE, TEXAS

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene duly advertised and gave such notice, as required by law, for bids for the Antilley and Memorial Traffic Signal Project. This construction contract involves installation of a new traffic signal at the Antilley and Memorial intersection, and all necessary removal and installation of pavement markings, signage, and other appurtenances required at the intersections.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene included an add alternate in the contract for removal of raised pavement markings and placement of new thermoplastic pavement markings from Memorial Dr. to S. Clack St.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene has utilized the “Best Value” competitive bidding method in determining the award of the contract; and,

WHEREAS, the following base bids were received and opened on March 12, 2024

Willis Electric Co. Lp., Abilene, Texas	\$479,885.00
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WHEREAS, the following add alternate bids were received and opened on March 12, 2024

Willis Electric Co. Lp., Abilene, Texas	\$34,000.00
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WHEREAS, Willis Electric Co. Lp., Abilene, Texas submitted the best value base bid and add alternate bid in the combined amount of \$513,885.00 with the bid meeting specifications. Staff recommends awarding the bid to the best value bidder, Willis Electric Co. Lp., Abilene, Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS

PART 1: That the City Council approves this bid in the amount of \$513,885.00.

PART 2: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after passage.


