

RESOLUTION NO. 83-2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AWARDING THE BID TO YOKOGAWA FLUID IMAGING TECHNOLOGIES, INC. FOR THE FLUID IMAGING SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (Abilene) owns and operates the Abilene Environmental Laboratory (AEL), which is nationally accredited by the NELAC Institute; and

WHEREAS, the AEL supports process control and compliance sampling and analysis for Abilene's Hamby Water Reclamation Facility and Abilene's Public Water Supply System, and it provides environmental laboratory services for various regional customers; and

WHEREAS, the AEL currently utilizes a fluid imaging system, Digital Imaging Particle Analyzer, for identifying and quantifying particles and organisms in water suspension of water and wastewater samples, and the instrument is aged, nonfunctional, obsolete, and replacement parts are no longer available; and

WHEREAS, the City received a single bid for a replacement Fluid Imaging System; and


WHEREAS, staff recommends awarding the bid for the Fluid Imaging System to the sole qualifying bidder Yokogawa Fluid Imaging Technologies, Inc. in the amount of \$130,385.75; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That the City Manager is authorized to purchase the Fluid Imaging System from Yokogawa Fluid Imaging Technologies, Inc. for the amount of \$130,385.75.
