

RESOLUTION NO. 93-2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVEING THE CONTRACT WITH INFRASTRUCTURE REHAB USA, INC. THROUGH PURCHASING COOPERATIVE OF AMERICA FOR THE REHABILITATION OF SEVEN SEWER MANHOLES.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene owns and operates the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility and the wastewater collection system serving Abilene, three satellite communities, and the Hawley ISD; and

WHEREAS, the collection system consists of approximately 830 miles of sewer mains, 8,126 manholes, and five lift stations; and

WHEREAS, a large percentage of Abilene's manholes were constructed many years ago utilizing bricks and mortar and over time the mortar has degraded resulting in water infiltration and structural failures; and

WHEREAS, Infrastructure Rehab USA, Inc. is able to offer manhole rehabilitation services through Purchasing Cooperative of America (PCA OD-368-22) at contract pricing in compliance with Texas Local Government Code Chapter 271; and

WHEREAS, City staff have selected 7 manholes which are in dire need for rehabilitation and the liners will add many years to the expected service life of the manholes; and


WHEREAS, City staff recommends that the Abilene City Council approve the contract with Infrastructure Rehab USA, Inc., available through Purchasing Cooperative of America at contract pricing in compliance with Texas Local Government Code Chapter 271, for the rehabilitation of seven sewer manholes for the amount of \$157,820.00; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


That the Abilene City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute the contract with Infrastructure Rehab USA, Inc. for the rehabilitation of seven sewer manholes for the amount of \$157,820.00.
