RESOLUTION NO. 102-2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH ENERGY TRANSFER

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene is currently constructing improvements along Maple Street, East of Lake Kirby; and

WHEREAS, several oil and gas pipelines run underneath Maple Street at Hardison Lane, and two of those pipelines are owned by Energy Transfer; and

WHEREAS, the improvements being constructed along Maple Street require relocation of the vent pipes, and extension of the casing of their two pipelines which lie underneath the roadway; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to enter into a Reimbursement Agreement with Energy Transfer, and Abilene will pay 75%, or up to \$161,250, of the actual costs incurred by Energy Transfer to relocate the vent pipes and increase the easing of their two pipelines.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

PART 1:

That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a Reimbursement Agreement with Energy Transfer in an amount not to exceed \$161,250.00.

PART 2: That this Resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
