

RESOLUTION NO. 109-2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY STAFF TO AUTHORIZE CONTRACTS FOR TEXAS COURTS AND WINDSCREENS THAT CUMULATIVELY ARE OVER \$50,000.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene had four separate stand-alone projects. Texas Courts and Windscreens was the low bid on all projects. Cumulatively, they will go over the \$50,000 threshold requiring City Council approval.; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approved \$300,000 MIP funds for league park improvements. The resurfacing of the Cal Young hockey rink is one of the approved improvements.; and

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene resurfaces two of the 15 courts annually at Rose Tennis Center as general maintenance to keep up with normal wear and tear from extensive use; and

WHEREAS, The City of Abilene is resurfacing the Sears basketball court and the Nelson Wilson half court as part of the FY 24 park improvements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


Part 1: The City Staff is hereby authorized to authorize contracts for Texas Courts and Windscreens that cumulatively are over \$50,000.

Part 2: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately from and after passage.
