

**RESOLUTION NO. 138-2024**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH ENPROTEC/HIBBS & TODD, INC. FOR THE HAMBY WRF SLUDGE POND REHABILITATION.**

**WHEREAS,** the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility and the associated wastewater collection system as authorized through TPDES Permit No. WQ0010334004 issued by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality; and

**WHEREAS,** the Permit authorizes the City to operate an onsite sewage sludge surface disposal unit consisting of engineered earthen berms, and maintaining a constant water cover; and

**WHEREAS,** the surface disposal unit needs major maintenance to repair wind and water erosion of berms, removal of excessive woody vegetation, and the removal of exposed sludge islands from within the basin; and

**WHEREAS,** the Professional Services Contract with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. (eHT) for the Hamby WRF Sludge Pond Rehabilitation will provide for the preparation of design plans and specifications for crest and slope repairs, the removal of woody vegetation, the restoration of slope protection, bidding assistance, construction phase services, and part-time project inspection services for an amount not to exceed \$108,900.00; and


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

That the City Manager is authorized to execute a professional services contract with Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd, Inc. for the Hamby WRF Sludge Pond Rehabilitation for the amount not to exceed \$108,900.00.


