

**RESOLUTION NO. 150-2024**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF A BAR SCREEN COMPACTOR UNIT FROM VISION EQUIPMENT FOR THE BUCK CREEK PUMP STATION.**

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility and the associated lift stations and wastewater collection system as authorized through TPDES Permit No. WQ0010334004 issued by the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality; and

WHEREAS, the Buck Creek Pump Station receives by gravity flow the municipal wastewater produced by Abilene and certain regional customers, processes it, and pumps it through a force main uphill to the Hamby Water Reclamation Facility; and

WHEREAS, the Buck Creek Pump Station utilizes coarse bar screens to remove large suspended solids which are subsequently fed through a compactor unit for dewatering and compaction before placement in a trailer for subsequent offsite disposal at a solid waste landfill; and

WHEREAS, Vision Equipment is the manufacturer's authorized distributor in this region for the replacement bar screen compactor unit for the Buck Creek Pump Station and can supply the needed unit for the price \$120,500.00; and

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:**

That the City Manager is authorized to purchase the Bar Screen Compactor Unit from Vision Equipment for the price of \$120,500.00.


