RESOLUTION NO. 165-2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS APPROVING FAA REIMBURSABLE AGREEMENT AMENDMENT AJW-FN-CSA-23-SW-005677-A1 FOR ABILENE REGIONAL AIRPORT.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates Abilene Regional Airport; and

WHEREAS, the Airport has need to relocate Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) communications lines under the site for the new air tanker ramp; and

WHEREAS, the FAA requires its participation in the oversight of such a relocation at the Airport's expense; and

WHEREAS, FAA has participated in the design of the relocation under Reimbursable Agreement (RA) AJW-FN-CSA-23-SW-005677 for \$29,494.80; and

WHEREAS, FAA now proposes to amend that RA to oversee the lines relocation for an additional \$143,079.14 through Amendment 1; and

WHEREAS, this cost is eligible for 90% funding through the TXDOT grant assisting with the cost of the ramp and the remaining 10% funded by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Airport Development Board approved its recommendation at its July 10, 2024 meeting.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

- 1. That the City Manager is authorized to enter into Reimbursable Agreement AJW-FN-CSA-23-SW-005677-A1 with FAA.
- 2. That this Amendment 1 brings the total RA amount to \$172,573.94.
- 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon Council approval.
