## **RESOLUTION NO. 201-2024**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A RENT ABATEMENT FOR BREVARD CAPITAL GROUP, INC.

WHEREAS, The City of Abilene (City) owns and operates Abilene Regional Airport; and

**WHEREAS**, City Council approved the lease of Car Rental Service Facility - Site B to Brevard Capital Group, Inc. through Resolution 63-2024; and

WHEREAS, after the lease was executed, Airport staff discovered that no electric meter had been placed at the site under a previous lease; and

WHEREAS, Airport staff believes it is a good faith gesture to help offset the unexpected cost to Brevard to bring electricity to the leased premises by offering a rent abatement of \$6,500.00; and

WHEREAS, by establishing electricity to the service facility. Brevard will be able to install a car wash system and expects to more than double its daily rental volume. This will also increase the rental car commissions the airport receives; and

WHEREAS, the Airport Development Board affirmed staff's recommendation and approved its recommendation to accept this rent abatement at its August 14, 2024 meeting.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

- 1. That the City Manager is authorized to execute this rent abatement in the amount of \$6,500.00.
- 2. That this Resolution shall be effective October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2025.
