RESOLUTION NO. 275-2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TO AUTHORIZE A CONSTRUCTION PHASE SERVICES TASK ORDER WITH GARVER FOR THE AIR TANKER RAMP CONSTRUCTION.

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene (City) owns and operates Abilene Regional Airport (ABI); and

WHEREAS, Garver is the airport's airside engineering firm and designed the Air Tanker Ramp Construction Project; and

WHEREAS, the construction phase will require engineer oversight, testing and inspection services, which is covered under Garver Master Engineering Services Contract; and

WHEREAS, Garver proposed a not-to-exceed fee of \$740,200.00 to perform Construction Administration, provide a Resident Project Representative, perform Materials Testing and provide Closeout Services; and

WHEREAS, Kutchins & Groh conducted an Independent Fee Estimate and determined that Garver's fee is well within the market range for these services; and

WHEREAS, the Airport Development Board approved its recommendation for this task order at its October 9, 2024 meeting.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

- 1. That the City Manager is authorized to enter into a task order with Garver for Construction Phase Services for the Air Tanker Ramp Construction Project.
- 2. That this Resolution takes effect immediately upon Council approval.
