

RESOLUTION NO. 276-2024

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH PARKHILL.

WHEREAS, The City of Abilene has received a grant and desires to install pedestrian improvements along Old Anson Rd. from Ambler Ave. to Old Anson Rd.; and

WHEREAS, the project includes federal funding via the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) which is being directed through Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT). Therefore, project execution is contingent upon concurrence with TxDOT; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Abilene has utilized the "Request for Qualifications" selection method in determining the award of the contract; and,

WHEREAS, the following firms submitted Statements of Qualification:

Jacob and Martin
Enprotec/Hibbs & Todd
Centurion

which were received on August 23, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, The City of Abilene has selected Parkhill for the schematic design, technical specifications and coordination with the City and TxDOT for said project; and,

WHEREAS, The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with Parkhill in the amount of \$213,000.00 for engineering services associated with the pedestrian improvements and the traffic signal modifications along Old Anson Road from Ambler Avenue to Interstate 20.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS

PART 1: The City Council authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with Parkhill.

PART 2: That the agreement is in the amount of \$213,000.00 for the design of the public improvements.


PART 3: That this resolution will take effect immediately from and after passage.
