

RESOLUTION NO. 15-2025

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS, TERMINATING INACTIVE CAMPAIGN TREASURER APPOINTMENTS FOR FILERS THAT HAVE BEEN INACTIVE FOR MORE THAN ONE YEAR

WHEREAS, a campaign treasurer may be removed by the filing of a successor or by resignation; and

WHEREAS, the city secretary must comply with state law requirements regarding campaign treasurers who remain active, even after the election has been concluded and the candidate is inactive; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 2, Article I, Section 2-6 of the Abilene Municipal Code, sets forth the procedures for the termination of inactive campaign treasurers; and

WHEREAS, the below inactive filers were notified by email and mail on January 2, 2025, that their campaign treasurer appointments could be terminated at this meeting, should they not bring their reports up to date, or file a final report, effectively terminating their campaign treasurer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:


PART 1: That the following inactive filers' campaign treasurer appointments be terminated with this Resolution:

PART 2: That this resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
