AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FRANCHISE OF O. B. FIELDER GRANTING HIM THE RIGHT TO OPERATE BUSES ON A PART OF NORTH FIRST STREET FROM ~~FINE~~ TO CEDAR STREET; AND A PART OF ELM STREET FROM SOUTH FIRST STREET TO SOUTH FOURTH STREET; AND WEST WAY DRIVE IN BELMONT ADDITION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That the franchise heretofore granted to O. B. Fielder to operate busses in the city of Abilene, be and the same is hereby amended by adding to the routes upon which said busses may be operated the following streets and portions thereof in said city, to-wit: part of North First Street from ~~Ohio~~ <sup>Cypress</sup> to Cedar Street, and the west half of the first alley north of North First St. to the east side of Main St. and a part of Elm Street, from South First Street to South Fourth Street, and West Way Drive in the Belmont Addition.
