January, 1942.

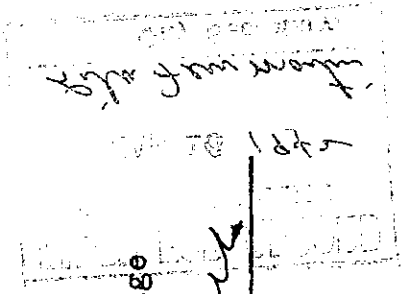

TO THE CITY COMMISSION OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Comes now City Service Bus Company, hereinafter called the petitioner and presents this its application for a permit to operate its buses on Ambler Street, between Pine and Hickory Streets, and for such application would show to the Commission as follows:

I

That at the present time said petitioner does not operate a bus between Pine and Hickory Streets on Ambler Street. That because of the fact that it does not now operate a bus on Ambler Street, between Pine and Hickory, it does not and cannot furnish direct service both ways to and from town on Pine and Hickory Streets.

II

That it would be to the advantage of the public and its patrons if it were allowed to operate a bus on Ambler Street, between Pine and Hickory, and that it would give the citizens of this town who reside in those districts direct bus service to and from town on both Pine and Hickory Streets.

WHEREFORE, your petitioner prays that it be granted a permit to operate its buses between Pine and Hickory Streets on Ambler Street.
