

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE I OF AN ORDINANCE PASSED ON THE 27TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 1940, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF TAXICABS AND TAXICAB DRIVERS IN THE CITY OF ABILENE; PRESCRIBING LICENSE FEES FOR TAXICABS AND DRIVERS THEREOF; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THE ORDINANCE; REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY," BY ADDING THERETO SECTION 5A.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That Article I of an ordinance passed by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene on the 27th day of December, A.D. 1940, bearing the Caption as stated in the Caption of this ordinance be and the same is hereby amended by adding Section 5a thereto, to read as follows, to wit:

"Section 5a. Each taxicab/operated in the City of Abilene shall have painted on each side thereof the name of the licensee or the name under which same is operated as stated in the application for license, and the permit number shall be painted on the back of the cab below the glass and on the front above the windshield, which name and numbers/shall be in letters and figures not less than three inches in height and in a strong contrasting color or colors from the color of the body of the cab, so that the same can be easily read by the public while the cab is being run on the streets of said city, and a violation of this provision shall be punished as provided in Article III, Section 18 of this Ordinance."
