AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 1 AND 2 OF AN ORDINANCE PASSED ON THE 2ND DAY OF DECEMBER 1938, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE SOLICITING OF BUSINESS ON ANY STREET OR SIDEWALK CARRYING A PENALTY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EMERGENCY BY INCLUDING THEREIN SOLICITORS FOR TAXICABS, PUBLIC BUSES, AND TRAVEL BUREAUS."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That Sections 1 and 2 of an ordinance passed by the Board

of Commissioners on the 2nd day of December, A.D. 1938, entitled

"An Ordinance Prohibiting the Soliciting of Business for Hotels on any street or sidewalk, carrying a penalty and providing for an emergency", so that said Sections 1 and 2 shall thereafter read as follows, towit:

"Section 1. It shall hereafter be unlawful for any person owning, operating or managing any hotel or rooming house, taxicab, public bus or travel bureau in the City of Abilene, either by himself or through another or for the agent or employee of such owner, operator or manager to solicit business for said hotel, rooming house, taxicab, public bus or travel bureau on any public street, sidewalk or alley in the City of Abilene."

"Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any owner, operator, or manager of any hotel or rooming house, taxicab, public bus or travel bureau in the City of Abilene either by himself or through another, or for the agent or employee of such owner, operator or manager to verbally solicit patronage for such a hotel, rooming house, taxicab, public bus or travel bureau who may at the time be upon any street, sidewalk or alley in the City of Abilene, whether or not the person or persons soliciting such patronage may at the time be upon any sidewalk, street or alley."

Passed at its first reading this the 26th day of February A.D., 1943.

Passed at its second and final reading on this the 5th

day of March A.D., 1943.
