AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ABILENE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR BUSES AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES GRANTING PERMITS OR PRIVILEGES TO W. O. KEMPER FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR BUSES IN THE CITY OF ABILENE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That Ordinance No. 177 of Ordinance Book 1, regulating the operation of motor busses in said City, passed on March 17, 1922; an Ordinance, finally passed on September 26, 1941, recorded in Ordinance Book No. 4, page 100, and an Ordinance finally passed on October 31, 1941, recorded in said book, page 102, granting to W. O. Kemper, doing business as the City Service Bus Company, permission to use certain streets for the operation of busses; an Ordinance passed December 20, 1940, granting to O. B. Fielder and his successors and assigns permission to operate busses on certain streets, recorded in Ordinance Book No. 4, page 50; an Ordinance passed on May 16, 1941, granting said O. B. Fielder permission to operate busses on certain streets, recorded in Ordinance Book No. 4, page 88; an Ordinance passed on April 22, 1932, granting permission to O. B. Fielder to operate busses on city streets recorded in Ordinance Book No. 3, page 325; an Ordinance passed on January 16, 1942, granting the application of City Service Bus Company to operate its lines over certain streets recorded in Ordinance Book No. 4, Page 130 of the City of Abilene are and hereby expressly repealed; and all rights, permits and privileges and franchises which said W. O. Kemper has, if any, for the operation of motor busses for hire on the public streets of said City are hereby revoked and annulled.

Passed on its first reading on the 1st day of December, 1944.

Passed on its second and final reading on the 8th day of December, 1944.
