

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OF STALLIONS, BULLS, AND JACKS WITHIN THE CITY OF ABILENE FOR THE PURPOSE OF BREEDING THE SAME TO FEMALE ANIMALS, IN SAID CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

That from and after the final passage of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to keep/within ^{or to aid or assist in keeping} the corporate limits of the City of Abilene any stallion or male

horse; any jack or male ass; or any bull or male of the cattle kind for the purpose of breeding said animals to female animals within said city. Any person ^{firm or corporation} violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, on conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than ten dollars, nor more than one hundred dollars, and each day of keeping said animal for said purpose shall be deemed a separate offense.
