

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE CITY LIMITS  
SO AS TO INCLUDE THE PROPERTY HEREIN DESCRIBED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS

SECTION I: WHEREAS, more than 51% of the residents of the following described property, entitled to vote in Taylor County, Texas, in elections for State Representatives have made application to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, requesting that said property, lying adjacent to and adjoining the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, be annexed to and included within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, said property being described as follows:

All of that certain tract of land situated in Taylor County, Texas, to-wit:

All of Blocks 1, 2 and 3 in Westway Park, an Addition to Abilene, Texas, and all alleys and portions of Oak Street, South 16th Street, South 17th Street and South 18th Street adjacent to said property, same being described by metes and bounds as follows:

Beginning at the NW corner of the NE 1/4 of Sec. 50, Blind Asylum Lands, which point is on the West line of Oak Street and on the present boundary line of the city limits of Abilene; Thence, N 89 degrees 34 mins. E with the North line of said NE 1/4 of Sec. 50, across Oak Street and along the North line of Block 3, Westway Park Addition, a total distance of 477.4 ft. to the NE corner of said Block 3, said course being along the present city limits of Abilene; Thence, South 0 degrees 30 mins. East, parallel to the west line of the NE 1/4 of said Sec. 50 and along the east line of Blocks 3, 2 and 1 of Westway Park Addition a total distance of 1073.6 ft. to an intersection with the South line of South 18th Street; Thence, west with the South line of South 18th Street a distance of 478.7 feet, more or less, to a point at the intersection of the South line of South 18th Street with the West line of Oak Street, said point being in the present city limits of Abilene; Thence, North along the West line of Oak Street, to the point of beginning.

SECTION II: That said above described property, as herein set out, be and the same is hereby declared annexed to the City of Abilene, as an integral part of said city, and incorporated within the limits of said city.

SECTION III: That the city limits of the City of Abilene be extended as follows, so as to include the above described property, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the north boundary line of NE 1/4 of Sec. 50, Blind Asylum Lands, 477.4 ft. east of the NW corner of same, said point being in the boundary line of the present city limits of Abilene, and the NE corner of Block 3, Westway Park Addition; Thence, South 0 degrees 30 mins East and along the east lines of Blocks 3, 2 and 1 of Westway Park Addition and continuing a total distance of 1073.6 ft. to an intersection with the South line of South 18th Street; Thence, west along the South line of South 18th Street a distance of 478.7 ft, more or less, to the intersection of the South line of South 18th Street with the West line of Oak Street, a point in the present city limits of Abilene.

SECTION IV: That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
