

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING BLOCKS 1
2, 3, 4 AND 5 AND ADJOINING
STREETS OF ARTHUR HENSON AD-
DITION TO THE CITY OF ABILENE,
TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented by the owner of
Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 and adjoining streets of Arthur Henson
Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:
That Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 and adjoining streets of Arthur Henson
Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, are hereby
annexed to and included within the territory of the City of Abilene,
said territory annexed being described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at the South East corner of Lot 13, Block 1 of said
Arthur Henson Addition and in the present city limits line;
THENCE North along the East boundary line of Block 1 of said
addition and along the present city limits line continuing North
across North 14th Street 785.4 feet to a point on the North bound-
ary line of North 14th Street;
THENCE North 89 deg. 56' West along the North boundary line of
North 14th Street 1536.1 feet to a point for corner.
THENCE South across North 14th Street continuing along the West
boundary line of Block 5 of said addition the total distance of 785.4
feet to the South West corner of Lot 10, Block 5 of said addition.
THENCE South 89 deg. 56' East along the South boundary line of
Block 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1, of said addition, 1536.1 feet to the place
of beginning.

Said territory is zoned in accordance with the Zoning Ordinance
the City of Abilene of 1946, and said territory is placed in Zone "B".
Passed on its first reading the 6th day of ~~April~~^{April}, 1949.

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where said
ordinance would be given public hearing and considered for final
passage, was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper
of general circulation in the City of Abilene, the first publication
being at least one week prior to the time advertised.
