

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING A PART OF NORTH PARK  
COMMON SCHOOL DISTRICT TO THE CITY OF ABILENE  
AND THE ABILENE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT  
FOR SCHOOL PURPOSES ONLY.

WHEREAS a petition has been presented to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, asking for the annexation of certain property contiguous and adjacent to said City, said property lying North/<sup>east</sup> and West of the present City limits and known as a part of North Park Common School District, and Jones Counties Taylor ~~County~~, Texas, and

WHEREAS it appears that said petition has been signed by a majority of the resident qualified voters of said territory and has been recommended by a majority vote of the Trustees of the Abilene Independent School District,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

THAT THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED PROPERTY BE AND IS HEREBY ANNEXED AND included within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene and the Abilene Independent School District for school purposes only, in accordance with the provisions of Article 2803, Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, as amended, said property being more fully described by metes and bounds as follows:

Field notes of the North Park Common Consolidated County Line School District No. 39 of Taylor County, Texas, as redefined by the County School Board on December 31, 1949.

BEGINNING at the Northwest corner of the City limits of Abilene, Texas, where same intersects Cat Claw Creek;

THENCE in an Easterly and Northerly direction to Pine Street;

THENCE South on Pine Street to Ambler Street;

THENCE East on Ambler Street to the Abilene and Northern Railroad;

THENCE South to North 14th Street;

THENCE in an easterly direction to Cedar Creek;

THENCE down Cedar Creek to a point due West of College Drive;

THENCE East to College Drive;

THENCE North to the City limits of Abilene;

THENCE East to the East Boundary line of Section 34, Blind Asylum Lands;

THENCE South to the Southeast corner of Section 34, Blind Asylum Lands;

THENCE West with the South boundary line of said Section 34;

to Cedarcrest Drive;

THENCE North and West to College Drive;

THENCE West to the Abilene and Northern Railroad;

THENCE South to the Southwest corner of Section 34;  
Blind Asylum Lands;

THENCE North to the Northeast corner of Section 81, in  
the name of Ephraim Anderson;

THENCE East to the Southeast corner of Survey No. 80,  
Thomas B. Johnson Survey;

THENCE North to the North Line of Taylor County;

THENCE West along the North line of Taylor County to  
Big Elm Creek;

THENCE down Big Elm Creek with its meanders to the  
Northeast corner of L. Landant Survey No. 17;

THENCE West with said North line to the Southwest  
corner of C. B. Buckholtz Survey No. 16;

THENCE North with the West line of said C. B. Buckholtz  
Survey to the Northwest corner of same;

THENCE East to the Southwest corner of R. Chamption Survey  
No. 15;

THENCE North to the Northwest corner of same;

THENCE EAST to the Southwest corner of the S. W. White  
Survey No. 14;

THENCE North to the South line of F. Sieberman Survey;

THENCE West with the South line and the North line  
of Survey No. 46 and the Abilene Delk Road;

THENCE West on the North Line of Section 45, to the  
Northwest corner of said Section No. 45;

THENCE in a Southeasterly direction with the West line  
of Section 45 to the Northeast corner of Section 6;

THENCE West with the North line of Section 6 to its  
Northwest corner;

THENCE South to the northeast corner of Section 49;

THENCE West with the North line of Section 49 to its  
Northwest corner;

Thence South with the West line of Section 49 to the  
North line of Section 50;

THENCE South with the West line of Survey No. 50 and  
Alexander Thompson Survey to the North Boundary line  
of Taylor County, Texas;

THENCE in a Northwesterly direction along the North boundary  
line of Taylor County to the intersection with David T.  
Bruce Survey No. 135;

THENCE South to the Southeast corner of same;

THENCE in a Westerly direction to the Northeast corner of Section No. 12, Block 16, E. & P. Railway Company Lands;

THENCE in a Southernly direction to the center line of T & P Railroad;


THENCE in an Easterly direction with the center line of the T & P Railroad to the West Boundary line of Abilene;

THENCE in a Northernly direction following the City Limits of Abilene to the Northwest corner of same, same being the place of beginning,


it being the intention to hereby describe North Park Common Consolidated County Line School District No. 39 as the same is described in Volume 2, Page 226-227 of the minutes of the County School Trustees of Taylor County, Texas, excepting therefrom that portion which has heretofore been annexed and made a part of the City of Abilene.

PASSED ON ITS FIRST READING THIS THE 30th day of June, A.D. 1950.

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, the first publication being at least one week prior to the time advertised. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on its second and final reading on the 14 day of July, A.D. 1950.
