

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING BLOCK NO. 13,
AND LOTS NOS. 1 TO 4, BLOCK NO. 14,
SECTION II, SOUTHWEST PARK ADDITION
TO THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY,
TEXAS, AND ADJOINING STREETS TO THE
CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, application has been presented by the owners of Block No. 13,
and Lots Nos. 1 to 4 of Block 14, and adjoining streets of Section II, Southwest
Park addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, to annex said
property to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY
OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

That Block No. 13, and Lots Nos. 1 to 4 of Block 14, and adjoining
streets of Section II, Southwest Park Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor
County, Texas, be and the same are hereby annexed to and included within the
territory of the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, said territory to be
annexed being described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point where the South line of Hunt Street
intersects the East line of Barrow Street;

THENCE West along the South line of Hunt Street a distance
of one thousand one hundred and ten feet (1110) to the West
property line of land belonging to LAWLER CONSTRUCTION COMPANY,
the same being the West line of a twenty foot alley on the
West side of Block No. 14, Section II, Southwest Park Addition
to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas;

THENCE South along the West line of said alley, a distance of
Two hundred fifty-seven (257) feet;

THENCE East a distance of one hundred forty five feet to the
West line of Ballinger Street;

THENCE in a Southeasterly direction across Ballinger Street
to the intersection of the East line of Ballinger Street and
the South line of South 18th Street;

THENCE East along the South line of South 18th Street across
Barrow Street, to a point in the East line of Barrow Street;

THENCE North along the East line of Barrow Street to the
place of beginning.

Said territory is zoned in accordance with the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, of 1946 and all of said Blocks and lots are placed in "E" Zone.

PASSED ON FIRST HEADING this the 9th day of February, A.D. 1951.

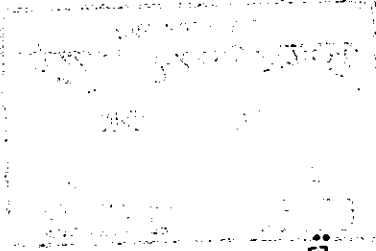
After said passage, a notice of thertime and place when and where said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News on the 13th day of February, 1951, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, the first publication being at least one week prior to the time advertised.

After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on its second and final reading on the ~~23rd~~^{30th} March day of February, A.D. 1951.
