

Ordinance No: 415

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING THAT PORTION OF A PUBLIC ROAD LYING IMMEDIATELY WEST OF LEGGETT DRIVE AND NOW COMPRISING A PART OF SECTION 5, ELMWOOD WEST ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS, AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A DEED, QUIT CLAIMING SAID PROPERTY TO W. S. WAGLEY, AND REPPS GUITAR, THE ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS.

WHEREAS, a public road known as the Abilene-Capps Road has heretofore been designated and dedicated to the public use, and

WHEREAS, that portion of said road which crosses Lots Nos. 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, and 24, and the alleyways abutting on Lots 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 19, and 20, All in Block Q, Section No. 5, of Elmwood West Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, has heretofore been abandoned, closed and re-routed by the Commissioners Court of the County of Taylor and the State of Texas, and

WHEREAS, it appears that said property can serve no useful purpose as a public road, and W. S. Wagley and Repps Guitar, the abutting property owners, have requested the Board of Commissioners to close, vacate and abandon said property as a public road and that title to said property be quit claimed to the abutting property owners as provided in Article 1017, Revised Civil Statutes, 1925, as amended;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:


SECTION 1. That all that portion of the old Abilene-Capps Road which lies immediately west of Leggett Drive and within Section No. 5, of Elmwood West Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, and now comprising parts of Lots Nos. 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, and 24 and the alleyways abutting on Lots 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 19, and 20, all in Block Q, Section No. 5, of Elmwood West Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, be and the same is hereby closed, vacated, and abandoned as a public road in the City of Abilene.

SECTION 2. That Mayor Hudson Smart be and he is hereby authorized and directed to execute a proper instrument quit claiming all right, title, and interest which the City of Abilene may have in said property.



PASSED ON FIRST HEADING this the 22nd day of December, A. D. 1950.

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be read and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, said publication being on the 26th day of December


