

ORDINANCE NO. 416

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE FIRING OF AIR RIFLES, PELLET GUNS OR B-B GUNS OR PISTOLS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE AND FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

SECTION I. After the effective date hereof, it shall be unlawful for any person to fire or discharge any air rifle, pellet gun, or B-B gun or pistol within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene.

SECTION II. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not to exceed ^{Two} ~~One~~ Hundred Dollars (\$~~200~~.00).

SECTION III. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its approval and final passage in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of the City of Abilene.

PASSED ON FIRST READING this the 5th day of January, A.D. 1951..

After said passage a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter-News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, the publication being on the 10th day of January A.D. 1951, at least one week prior to the time advertised. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was read and passed on its SECOND AND FINAL READING on the 19th day of January, A.D. 1951.
