AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAMES AND DESIGNATION OF VARIOUS STREETS IN THE CITY OF ABILENE, AS AMENDED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

SECTION 1: That the portion of the hereinafter named streets set forth in Column 1, below, be, and the same is hereby renamed and redesignated as hereinafter set forth, as follows:

SECTION 2: That the City Engineer be, and he is hereby directed to amend the official map of the City of Abilene, to show the changes hereby ordered. PASSED ON THE FIRST READING, this 6th day of June, A. D. 1952.

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance to be given a public hearing was given by publication in the Abilene Reporter-News, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, the date of said publication being the 10 th day of June, A. D. 1952; and after said notice and public hearing duly had, said ordinance was amended in the following particulars, to-wit:

"Commissioner Walker made a motion duly seconded by Commissioner Perry and carried that the Ordinance as read on 1st reading changing the names of various streets, be amended so that Fourth Avenue between Highland and Thelma Street be changed to Over Street and that Murfee Street between Vine and Sayles Blvd. be changed to Over Street. All Commissioners voted "Aye".

"Commissioner Perry made a motion duly seconded by Commissioner Conerly and carried, that the ordinance as read on first reading changing the names of various streets be amended and the street which begins at the intersection of Portland Street and an unnamed Street, and which extends East to Waverly Avenue be named Edgemont Drive. All Commissioners voted "Aye" except Commissioner Walker. Mayor Grissom voted "Aye"."

SECTION 3: Said ordinance, having been ordered amended as aforesaid, it is further ordained that the portion of the hereinafter named streets set forth in Column No. 1 below be, and the same are hereby renamed and redesignated as hereinafter set forth, as follows:

which extends to Portland Street.

SECTION 4: It is further ordained that any and all parts of Section No. 1 of this ordinance which are in conflict with Section No. 3 above, be and the same are hereby repealed and of no further force and effect.

SECTION 5: Said ordinance having been amended after passage on the first reading, it was ordered that another public hearing be had on the matter at 9:00 A. M. on June 27, 1952, and that notice of such hearing be published in the Abilene Reporter-News at least three days prior to the time stated as provided by Section 32-b of the City Charter; such notice having been published on the 23 day of June, 1952, said hearing was had on June 27, 1952, and said ordinance, having been read in full at that time, the ordinance, as amended, was passed on second and final reading on the 27th day of June, A. D. 1952.
