

ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING HOUSTON STREET FROM E. N. 14TH STREET TO E. N. 19TH STREET, AS SHOWN BY T. C. CAMPBELL'S REPLAT OF COLLEGE DRIVE ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE QUITCLAIM DEEDS TO THE ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS; PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, according to the official plat of T. C.

Campbell's Replat of College Drive Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, recorded in Vol. 1, page 621, of the Plat Records, Taylor County, Texas, Houston Street, extending from E. N. 14th Street to E. N. 19th Street, has been dedicated to the public; and

WHEREAS, the need for said street has ceased to exist and is no longer used as such; and

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners have requested the Board of Commissioners to close, vacate and abandon said street as a public passageway, and to have the same deeded to the abutting property owners in order that the same may be maintained, all as provided by Article 1017 of the Revised Civil Statutes of Texas, 1925, as amended;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

SECTION 1: That that portion of Houston Street lying between E. N. 14th Street and E. N. 19th Street, as shown on T. C. Campbell's Replat of College Drive Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, as recorded in Vol. 1, page 621, Plat Records, Taylor County, Texas, is hereby closed, vacated and abandoned as a public street of the City of Abilene.

SECTION 2: That Mayor Ernest Grissom be and he is hereby authorized to execute proper conveyances relinquishing said property to the various abutting property owners.

PASSED ON FIRST READING this 7th day of November, 1952.

After said passage, a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, the publication being on the 10th day of November, 1952, at least ten days prior to the time advertised. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said Ordinance was passed on its second and final reading on the 21st day of November, 1952.
