

ORDINANCE NO. 541

ORDINANCE CLOSING, VACATING AND ABANDONING THAT CERTAIN DESIGNATED STREET SIXTY FEET WIDE BETWEEN AUSTIN AND HOUSTON STREETS, WHICH IS BORDERED ON THE NORTH BY BLOCK 32 AND ON THE SOUTH BY BLOCKS 23 AND 24, COLLEGE DRIVE ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE QUITCLAIM DEEDS TO THE ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, that certain tract of land sixty feet wide between Austin and Houston Streets, which is bordered on the north by Block 32 and on the south by Blocks 23 and 24, College Drive Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, has been designated as a street; and

WHEREAS, no need exists for said street and same is not now used as such; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Commission of the City of Abilene has recommended that such designated street be closed, vacated and abandoned as a public passageway;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

SECTION 1: That such designated street which is 60 feet wide between Austin and Houston Streets, which is bordered on the north by Block 32 and on the south by Blocks 23 and 24, College Drive Addition to the City of Abilene, Taylor County, Texas, is hereby closed, vacated and abandoned as a public street of the City of Abilene.

SECTION 2: That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized to execute proper conveyances quitclaiming said property to the various abutting property owners.

PASSED ON FIRST READING this 12th day of June, 1953.

After the passage of said ordinance on first reading, it being deemed necessary to pass this ordinance to meet an emergency in accordance with Section 32 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, the rule requiring publication at

least one week prior to a public hearing and requiring such hearing, was suspended by vote of four members of the Board of Commissioners, and said ordinance was read and passed on second and final reading on the 12th day of June, 1953.
