

ORDINANCE NO. 562

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE AMENDING  
SECTION 12 (b) 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 432 OF THE  
CITY OF ABILENE PASSED THE 10TH DAY OF AUGUST,  
1951, AND REFERRED TO AS "ORDINANCE OF THE  
CITY OF ABILENE REGULATING TAXICAB TRANSPOR-  
TATION"; CHANGING THE RATE OF FARE TO BE  
CHARGED THEREUNDER; PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC  
HEARING.

WHEREAS, Section 12 (b) 1 of Ordinance No. 432 of the City of Abilene passed the 10th day of August, 1951, provided "the rate of fare for one person shall be 30 cents for the first mile or fraction thereof traveled by the passenger and 5 cents for each additional one-quarter mile or fraction thereof traveled by him. For each additional passenger transported on the same trip, the charge shall be 20 cents regardless of the distance traveled." and;

WHEREAS, a committee appointed by the City Commission composed of B. R. Blankenship, Ben Davis and John Pope have recommended the amending of the rates, and the City Commission concurred in the recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

SECTION 1: That Section 12 (b) 1 of Ordinance No. 432 passed the 10th day of August, 1951, and entitled "Ordinance of the City of Abilene regulating Taxicab Transportation" shall be amended to read as follows:

1. The rate of fare for one person shall be 25 cents for the first one-half mile or fraction thereof traveled by the passenger and 10 cents for each additional one-half mile or fraction thereof traveled by him. For each additional passenger transported on the same trip, the charge shall be 20 cents regardless of the distance traveled.

2. This ordinance shall become effective immediately after its passage on second and final reading.

PASSED ON FIRST READING, this 29th day of January, 1954.

After said passage a notice of the time and place when and where said ordinance would be given a public hearing and considered for final passage was published in the Abilene Reporter News, a daily newspaper of general circulation in the City of Abilene, the publication being on the 30 day of February, 1954, at least one week prior to the time advertised. After such opportunity for the public to be heard, said ordinance was passed on its second and final reading on the 12th day of February, 1954.
