

ORDINANCE NO. 593

ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF ABILENE ALL OF SECTION 4, SOUTHWEST PARK ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ABILENE, TAYLOR COUNTY, TEXAS; ZONING SAID PROPERTY AS "B" ZONE; AND CALLING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the following described property is land and territory lying adjacent to the present city limits of the City of Abilene; and

WHEREAS, it appears expedient and necessary to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene that said property be annexed to the City of Abilene in accordance with the request filed with the Board of Commissioners by the owner of said property:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE:

SECTION 1: That in accordance with the provisions of Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, as amended, the following described property is hereby annexed to and included within the corporate limits of the City of Abilene, said territory being continuous and adjacent to the present city limits and being described as follows:

BEGINNING at that point on the west boundary line of the City Limits of the City of Abilene where the same intersects the south boundary line of Southwest Park Addition, Section 4;

THENCE West along the south boundary line of Section 4 of Southwest Park Addition to the City of Abilene to the Southwest corner thereof, being a point in the west boundary line of the alley just west of Ballinger Street;

THENCE North along the west boundary line of Section 4, Southwest Park Addition and of said alley to the present city limit line.

SECTION 2: That upon final passage hereof said property as annexed shall be a part of the City of Abilene, and the property situated therein shall bear its pro rata part of the taxes levied by the City, and the inhabitants thereof shall be entitled to all the rights and privileges of all the citizens

and shall be bound by the acts, ordinances and resolutions and regulations of the City.

SECTION 3: That said property in accordance with the recommendation of the City Planning & Zoning Commission shall be in Zone "B" (Two-Family Residence).

SECTION 4: That a public hearing be held at 9:00 A.M. on the 3rd day of September, 1954, in the Chambers of the Board of Commissioners at the City Hall in Abilene, Texas, at which time all interested persons shall be given full opportunity to be heard in opposition of or support of said annexation.

PASSED ON FIRST READING, this the 30th day of July, 1954.

After said passage, said ordinance was published in final form in the Abilene Reporter News on the 3rd day of August, 1954, same being a daily newspaper of general circulation published in the City of Abilene, and which date was more than 30 days prior to the date which said ordinance was finally acted upon.

PASSED ON SECOND AND FINAL READING this 3rd day of September, 1954.
