Ordinance 713

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ABILENE AMENDING
ORDINANCE NO. 157 AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 1,
PAGE 241 OF THE ORDINANCE RECORDS; DECLARING
AN EMERGENCY; PASSING THE SAME ON SECOND AND
FINAL READING.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE
CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

SECTION I: That Ordinance No. 157 as recorded in Volume
1, Page 241 of the Ordinance Records of the City of Abilene,
Texas, entitled "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING ANY PERSON, OR
CORPORATION OR ASSOCIATION OF PERSONS IN THE CITY OF ABILENE,
TEXAS FROM HAVING IN HIS OR THEIR POSSESSION FOR THE PURPOSE
OF SALE, EXHIBITING FOR SALE, OR BARTER OR SELLING, TRADING,
OR GIVING AWAY IN SAID CITY, ANY FIRE CRACKER, ROMAN CANDLE,
FIZZER, TOY CANNON, FIRE CLUB, GIANT CRACKER, FIRE WHEELS
OR ANY KIND OF AN ARTICLE MANUFACTURED OR SOLD FOR FIRE OR
LIGHT DISPLAY OF ANY SUBSTANCE, IGNITED BY FIRE OR BY COM-
BUSTION OF FRICTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMUSEMENT, ENTERTAINMENT
OR PLEASURE, PROHIBITING ANY PERSON WHILE IN THE CORPORATE
LIMITS OF SAID CITY FROM USING, IGNITING OR BURSTING OR
EXPLODING ANY OF THE ABOVE ENUMERATED FIRE WORKS, PROVIDING
A PENALTY ETC.", is amended to add the following to Section
Two thereof, "provided that any of the fire works as set out
in Section One, may be stored and ignited by a special permit
of the City Commission and when precautions have been taken
to protect the same, and the public, as may be required by
the Fire Marshal and the Chief of the Abilene Fire Department."
SECTION II: No other portions of the said Ordinance shall
be affected, and the balance of the same shall be in full
force and effect as therein written.

PASSED on first reading this 6 day of April, 1956.

After the passage of said Ordinance, on first reading, it
being deemed necessary to pass this Ordinance to meet an
emergency in accordance with Section 32 of the Charter of
the City of Abilene, the rule requiring publication at least one
week prior to a public hearing and requiring such hearing,

was suspended by a vote of four members of the Board of Commissioners, and said ordinance was read and passed on Second and final reading on the 6th day of April, 1956.

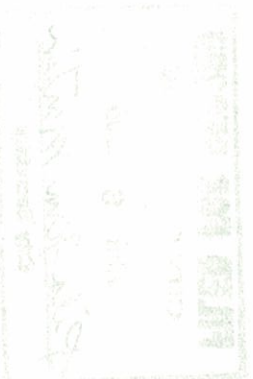
