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AN ORDINANCE CLOSING THAT PORTION OF FANNIN STREET LYING AND BEING SITUATED BETWEEN NORTH 1ST AND NORTH 2ND STREETS IN THE CITY OF ABILENE; MAKING AND MANIFESTING A QUIT-CLAIM DEED TO SAID PROPERTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the portion of Fannin Street lying and being situated between North 1st and North 2nd Streets in the City of Abilene be and the same is hereby closed, vacated and abandoned, it being deemed in the best interest of the city that the same no longer be maintained as a public street.

Section 2: That the City of Abilene hereby and herein quit-claims unto Jack Yonge, the owner of the property abutting on both sides of the portion of Fannin Street herein closed, all of the city's right, title and interest in and to said property to have and to hold unto Jack Yonge, his heirs and assigns forever.

Section 3: That the City of Abilene herein reserves unto itself a perpetual easement in and on said property hereby quit-claimed for the purpose of installing, maintaining and keeping in repair water and sewer mains and lines, street lights and poles and other similar utilities, with full right of ingress and egress necessary to maintain said utility easement.


PASSED ON FIRST READING, this the 15th day of November, 1956.

The Board of Commissioners hereby finds that an emergency exists requiring suspension of the rule provided in Section 32 of the City Charter requiring ordinances to

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be read and passed at two separate meetings of the Board of Commissioners and said rule is hereby suspended and said ordinance is passed twice at one and the same meeting of the Board of Commissioners.
