ORDINANCE NO. 780

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE AND THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN ADDITIONAL TERRITORY LYING ADJACENT TO AND SURROUNDING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, SAID ADDITIONAL TERRITORY BEING AS HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED.

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas, provides that the City shall have power, by ordinance, to fix and change the boundaries and limits of the city and to provide for the extension of said boundaries and limits and the annexation of additional territory lying adjacent to the city with or without the consent of the territory and inhabitants thereof annexed; and

WHEREAS, it appears expedient and necessary to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, that certain property hereinafter described be annexed for all purposes in accordance with the City Charter; NOW THEREFORE;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE,

TEXAS:

Section 1: That the boundary and limits of the City of Abilene are hereby changed and fixed and the extension thereof provided for, and the present boundaries and limits of said city are hereby changed so as to include all of that territory lying and being situated adjacent to the city limits of the City of Abilene and described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the present city limits at the intersection of South 32nd St. and Grand Ave., said point being 244.3' East and 1335' South from the NW corner of Section 64, Blind Asylum Lands, said point being 50' South and 10' East from the SW corner of Block 15, Edgement Addition, said point also being the beginning of a curve, Southwesterly to the right;

THENCE following the East property line of Grand Ave. around said curve to the right whose long chord bears 516°52' W, and whose central angle is 33°48' and whose radius is 530.7' for a distance of 313.0' along the curve to the end of the curve;

THENCE S 33°46' W 69.8' to the beginning of a curve to the left;

THENCE around said curve to the left whose long chord bears S 16°53' W, and whose radius is 451.3' and whose central angle is 33°46' for a distance of 265.9' to the end of the curve;

THENCE South continuing along the East property line of Grand Ave. 1586.2' to the beginning of a curve to the right, being the intersection of the South property line of Sayles Blvd. and the East property line of Grand Ave.;

THENCE in a Northeasterly direction along said curve to the right, whose long chord bears N 28°22' 30" E and whose central angle is 56°45' and whose radius is 384.1' for a distance of 380.4' to the end of the curve;

THENCE N 56°45' E 636.9' to the beginning of a curve to the left;

THENCE around said curve to the left whose long chord bears N 42°49' E and whose central angle is 27°52' and whose radius is 488.0' for a distance of 237.3' being the intersection of the East property line of Sayles Blvd. and the South property line of South 36th St.;

THENCE S 65°48' E 21.9' to the beginning of a curve to the left;

THENCE around said curve to the left whose long chord bears South 77°54' E and whose central angle is 24°12' and whose radius is 343.2' for a distance of 144.9';

THENCE East 50.0';

THENCE North 1387.0' to the present city limits;

THENCE S 89°59' W 872.3' to the place of beginning and containing 38.85 acres more or less.

Section 2: That upon final passage hereof, said property as annexed shall be a part of the City of Abilene, Texas, and the property situated therein shall bear its pro rata portion of the taxes levied by the city, and the inhabitants thereof shall be entitled to all of the rights and privileges of all of the citizens and shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, rules and regulations of the city.

Section 3: That the City Engineer shall change the records of his office to conform to the new boundaries and limits of the City of Abilene as changed and fixed by this ordinance.

Section 4: The aforesaid boundary and limits shall include the territory over which the City of Abilene has jurisdiction.

PASSED ON FIRST READING this the 31st day of January, 1957.



PASSED ON SECOND AND FINAL READING, this 14th day of March, 1957.




