

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING THE RIGHT TO THE ABILENE AND SOUTHERN RAILWAY CO. TO SHIFT THE LOCATION OF A SWITCH AT THE INTERSECTION OF SEVENTH ST. AND ROSE ST. AND TO BUILD OPERATE AND MAINTAIN TRACK CONNECTIONS THERETO; AND TO BUILD, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN AN ADDITIONAL SWITCH TRACK OR SPUR TRACK IN ROSE ST. OPPOSITE BLOCKS D, C, B, AND A OF MOUSER & MILLER SUBDIVISION OF BLOCKS 191 AND 192 OF THOMAS ADDITION TO THE CITY OF ABILENE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the right and privilege be and the same is hereby granted to Abilene and Southern Railway Company to remove a turnout switch connecting the most westerly tracks in the intersection of Seventh St. and Rose St. and to reconstruct such turnout switch at a point in Rose St. approximately 140 feet north of its present location and to build, operate and maintain in Rose St. track connections to such turnout switch with the most westerly track adjacent to Block "L" immediately south of Seventh St., and with the most westerly track adjacent to Block 135, immediately north of Seventh St.; and to build, operate and maintain a switch track or spur track in Rose St. in and along Rose St. opposite Blocks D. C. B. and A of Mouser & Miller Subdivision of Blocks 191 and 192 Thomas Addition to the City of Abilene.

Section 2: That the right and privilege hereby granted is subject to the condition that such building and maintenance shall be done so as to interfere as little as possible with the public travel over the street.

PASSED on first reading this 4th day of ~~March~~ ^{April}, 1957.
