AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE AND THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN ADDITIONAL TERRITORY LYING ADJACENT TO AND SURROUNDING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, SAID ADDITIONAL TERRITORY BEING AS HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED.

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas, provides that the City shall have power, by ordinance, to fix and change the boundaries and limits of the city and to provide for the extension of said boundaries and limits and the annexation of additional territory lying adjacent to the city with or without the consent of the territory and inhabitants thereof annexed; and

WHEREAS, it appears expedient and necessary to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, that certain property hereinafter described be annexed for all purposes in accordance with the City Charter; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the boundary and limits of the City of Abilene are hereby changed and fixed and the extension thereof provided for, and the present boundaries and limits of said city are hereby changed so as to include all of that territory lying and being situated adjacent to the city limits of the City of Abilene and described as follows, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the present city limits, said point being 20 feet south and 20 feet west of the southwest corner of Lot 5, Blk 6, Hillcrest Addition Section 1, and being on the North R.O.W. Line of Ambler Ave.;

THENCE West along the North R.O.W. line of Ambler to a point 80 feet North of the Northwest corner of Lot 29, Blk, 34, Abilene Heights Addition Continuation;

THENCE North 140 feet;

THENCE East to a point 140 feet North of the place of beginning;

THENCE South 140 feet to the place of beginning. Being a portion of survey 23, Blind Asylum Lands.

Section 2: That upon final passage hereof, said property annexed shall be a part of the City of Abilene, Texas, and the property situated therein shall bear its pro rata portion of the taxes levied by the city, and the inhabitants thereof shall be entitled to all of the rights and privileges of all of the citizens and shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, rules and regulations of the city.

Section 3: That the City Engineer shall change the records of his office to conform to the new boundaries and limits of the City of Abilene as changed and fixed by this ordinance.

Section 4: The aforesaid boundary and limits shall include the territory over which the City of Abilene has jurisdiction.

PASSED ON FIRST READING this the 14th day of March, 1957.

The City Secretary is hereby directed to publish this ordinance at least one time in the Abilene Reporter News and it shall not be finally passed until at least thirty (30) days have elapsed after said publication thereof.

PASSED ON SECOND AND FINAL READING, this 25<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1957.

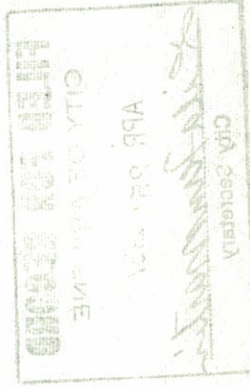
