

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE AND THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN ADDITIONAL TERRITORY LYING ADJACENT TO AND SURROUNDING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, SAID ADDITIONAL TERRITORY BEING AS HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED

Ordinance # 816

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas provides that the City shall have power, by ordinance, to fix and change the boundaries and limits of the city and to provide for the extension of said boundaries and limits and the annexation of additional territory lying adjacent to the city with or without the consent of the territory and inhabitants thereof annexed; and

WHEREAS, it appears expedient and necessary to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, that certain property hereinafter described be annexed for all purposes in accordance with the City Charter;

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the Boundary and Limits of the City of Abilene, Texas are hereby changed and fixed and the extension thereof provided for, and the present boundaries and limits of said city are hereby changed so as to include all of that certain tract of land lying adjacent to the City of Abilene and being particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the East Boundary Line of Minter Lane with the South Boundary Line of North 14th Street;

THENCE in a westerly direction along the South Boundary Line of North 14th Street, to a point the intersection of the East Boundary Line of Glendale Drive with the South Boundary Line of North 14th St.;

THENCE in a southerly direction along the East Boundary Line of Glendale Drive to the intersection of the East Boundary Line of Glendale Drive with the North Boundary Line of N. 12th Street;

THENCE in an easterly direction along the North Boundary Line of North 12th Street, to a point the intersection of the North Boundary Line of North 12th Street with the East Boundary Line of Minter Lane;

THENCE in a northerly direction with the East Boundary Line of Minter Lane, and along the present City Limits, to the place of beginning.

Section 2: That upon final passage hereof, said property annexed shall be a part of the City of Abilene, Texas, and the property situated therein shall bear its pro rata portion of the taxes levied by the City of Abilene and the inhabitants thereof shall be entitled to all of the rights and privileges of all of the citizens and shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, rules and regulations of the City.

Section 3: That the City Engineer shall change the records of his office to conform to the new boundaries and limits of the City of Abilene as changed and fixed by this ordinance.

Section 4: That said property from and after the time of its annexation shall be Zoned "B" Dwelling District.

Section 5: The aforesaid boundary and limits shall include territory over which the City of Abilene has jurisdiction.

Section 6: Nothing herein contained shall be construed as a repeal or abandonment of that certain annexation ordinance passed on first reading on March 14, 1957, ^{and still pending, which said ordinance included other lands as well as those described hereinabove.} *Not that ordinance passed on first reading on October 24, 1957.*

PASSED ON FIRST READING This the ^{31st} day of October, 1957.

It appearing to the Board of Commissioners that a petition, duly signed and duly presented by all owners of the property sought to be annexed in this ordinance has been received by the Board of Commissioners; and it appearing to the Board of Commissioners that an emergency exists requiring the annexation of the property above described without giving notice thereof under Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas, said Board of Commissioners hereby finds that an emergency exists and does pass this ordinance on second and final reading This the 31st day of October, 1957.

WHEREAS, The Board of Trustees of the Abilene Independent School District hold title to all property hereinafter described, with the exception of that portion of Minter Lane described herein-after; and

WHEREAS, said Board of Trustees, for the Abilene Independent School District, at a legal meeting, authorized the person whose signature appears hereafter, to execute this petition on behalf of said board asking the City of Abilene to annex the property hereinafter described;

NOW THEREFORE KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the Board of Trustees for the Abilene Independent School District hereby petition the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene to annex, under its emergency powers, without notice, the property hereinafter described:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the East Boundary Line of Minter Lane with the South Boundary Line of N. 14th Street;

THENCE in a westerly direction along the South Boundary Line of North 14th Street, to a point, the intersection of the East Boundary Line of Glendale Drive with the South Boundary line of North 14th Street;

THENCE in a southerly direction along the East Boundary line of Glendale Drive to the intersection of the East Boundary Line of Glendale Drive with the North Boundary Line of N. 12th Street;

THENCE in an easterly direction along the North Boundary Line of North 12th Street, to a point the intersection of the North Boundary Line of North 12th Street with the East Boundary Line of Minter Lane;

THENCE in a northerly direction with the East Boundary Line of Minter Lane, and along the present City limits, to the place of beginning.
