

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE AND THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN ADDITIONAL TERRITORY LYING ADJACENT TO AND SURROUNDING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, SAID ADDITIONAL TERRITORY BEING AS HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED.

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the Charter of the City of Abilene, Texas, provides that the City shall have power, by ordinance to fix and change the boundaries and limits of the city and to provide for the extension of said boundaries and limits and the annexation of additional territory lying adjacent to the city with or without the consent of the territory and inhabitants thereof annexed; and

WHEREAS, it appears expedient and necessary to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Abilene, that certain property hereinafter described be annexed for all purposes in accordance with the City Charter; NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ABILENE, TEXAS:

Section 1: That the boundary and limits of the City of Abilene are hereby changed and fixed and the extension thereof provided for, and the present boundaries and limits of said city are hereby changed so as to include all of that territory hereinafter described, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the present city limits, said point being the Northwest corner of Lot 6, John J. Toombs Subdivision of parts of Lots 1 & 2, Block 210, Original City of Abilene, Texas;

THENCE S 1° 02' West along the present City Limits 648.2 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 13 of said John J. Toombs Subdivision; THENCE North 89° 22' East 407 feet to the Southeast corner of Lot 1 of said John J. Toombs Subdivision;

THENCE North 0° 24' East along the East Boundary Line of said Lot 1 to its Northeast corner.

THENCE North 85° West 402 feet to the place of beginning.

Section 2: That upon final passage hereof, the property herein above annexed shall be Zoned as Zone "B".

Section 3: That upon final passage hereof, said property annexed shall be a part of the City of Abilene, Texas, and the property situated

therein shall bear its pro rata portion of the taxes levied by the City of Abilene and the inhabitants thereof shall be entitled to all of the rights and privileges of all of the citizens and shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, rules and regulations of the city.

Section 4: That the City Engineer shall change the records of his office to conform to the new boundaries and limits of the City of Abilene as changed and fixed by this ordinance.

Section 5: The aforesaid boundary and limits shall include territory over which the City of Abilene has jurisdiction.

PASSED ON FIRST READING this the 29th day of August, 1957.

The City Secretary is hereby directed to publish this ordinance at least one time in the Abilene Reporter News and it shall not be finally passed until at least thirty (30) days have elapsed after said publication thereof.

PASSED ON SECOND AND FINAL READING, this the 7th day of November, 1957.
